



REPORT

Lords Institute of Engineering and Technology as part of National Service Scheme (NSS) organized a seminar on Awareness Programme on ArogyaSetu App and Covid 19 at Attapur, Doodh Bowli Village on 22-04-2020. The Arogya Setu App is a government initiative to ensure the utmost safety for its citizens from the deadly virus. The volunteers created awareness among the public of Attapur, Doodh Bowli about AROGYASETUAPP AND COVID-19. The seminar was to sensitize the participants on Covid issues, to help them be aware of virus get informed about infected persons in contact in order to take quick action. They were informed about the usage of the App- that kept track of other app users that a person came in contact with. It then alerts app users if any of the contacts tests positive for COVID-19.

The App makes use of the phone's Bluetooth and GPS facility. The time, proximity, location and duration of the affected person can be recorded.

The students actively participated in the seminar wherein various doubts were clarified. Nearly 400 students participated in the seminar held on ArogyaSetu App and Covid 19.
